Guidelines for attendance of Showjumping Competition under Covid 19 restrictions

- . All classes must be pre-entered at www.bookingbee.uk
- . Times will be published on Beirc Facebook page and website by the Friday before the competition.
- . The course plan will be available on Beirc Facebook page and website the Saturday evening before the competition. The course remain the same for all classes.
- . Competition is run as Single Phase. There will be one round of jumps, the second half will be against the clock and faults will be accumulated over the two rounds.
- . On arrival please park allowing adequate distance cones will be set up to assist.
- . Please let us know if you need to withdraw by texting 07898603064 or 07761294425. There is no need to announce your arrival on the day.
- . **Course Walk** The course will be available to walk on the day please note due to competitor bubbles there may be additional course walk during the class please use the course walk directly before your section. Face coverings must be worn by those walking the course unless aged 12yrs and under, please observe social distancing. Riders 18yrs and under can have a helper/parent walk the course with them.
- . Warm-up You will be allocated three times, Outdoor Flatwork, Indoor Jump and Round. This will allow for 30mins of warm up. Only 5 in the warm-up at one time. We have a "One Way system" in operation (see plan), once you have jumped your round you can use the tracks as a cool down please do not re-enter the outdoor warm-up. There will be a steward in the warm-up arena who is solely responsible for the adjustment of the practice fences please be courteous towards them. The gates into and exiting the main arena will be attended by a steward. The entrance door to the warm-up arena will be left open.
- . Parents/helpers Please use the entrance between the two arenas to view or the exit gate from the main arena. This is a NO spectator sport so please do not hang around to watch others.
- . **Results** These will be announced at the end of each class and posted on Beirc Fb page there will be no prizegiving Rosettes will be available for collection at the exit door from the main arena after the results have been announced. Please let us know if you are unable to collect your rosette.
- . Please bring your own equipment to remove muck from the carpark.
- . **Catering** The Café is open for limited indoor and outdoor seating and takeaway please wear a face covering and observe their one-way system enter via the glass doors on the side of the building. Please support them if you can.
- . Toilet facilities are open, please use hand sanitiser and observe rules displayed
- . Please DO NOT ATTEND if you are displaying any symptoms related to Covid or are self isolating.
